## Instructions to Authors

**ESPERIANA** is a peer-reviewed international journal for publication of high quality papers on systematic zoology, especially for monographs and revisions and larger taxonomic works.

Submission of a paper for ESPERIANA implies that it has not been published previously and it is not under consideration for publication elsewhere.

Papers must be in German or English with British spelling, and be original contributions in the field of insect taxonomy, systematics, zoogeography and ecology. Nomenclature must be in agreement with the ICZN International Code of Zoological Nomenclature (2000). If possible, use the common font Arial and use as little formatting as possible.

Style of terms: **Latin names:** e.g. *Cryphia*

**Proper names:** e.g. Charles BOURSIN

**Abstract** should be a brief summary of the contents and not be longer than 200 words.

**Key words** should not be more than five key word entries.

**Illustrations** Legends of illustrations should be listed after "References". Small illustrations should be grouped into plates. **Tables**, if any, should be given at the end of the manuscript.

**Periodicals** should be abbreviated in the World List of Scientific Periodicals (4th edn 1963). References should contain only those given in the text, listed alphabetically at the end of the manuscript. All literature cited in the text must be listed in the references in the following format:

BOURSIN, Ch. (1954): Zwei neue *Cryphia* Hb. (*Bryophila*) -Arten aus dem vorderasiatisch-mediterranen Faunenkreis. – Zeitschrift der Wiener Entomologischen Gesellschaft **39**: 85-89.

**Journal titles must be written in full (not abbreviated).** For websites, it is important to include the last date when you see that site, as it can be moved or deleted from that address in the future.

All necessary illustrations should accompany the manuscript, but should not be inserted in the text. They should be fully numbered in the order in which they are referred to in the text. The size of original drawings or photos should not be more than DIN A 3.

Only standard abbreviations should be used, otherwise they should be defined. The following symbols should be used for:

**Editorial progressing of papers.** Authors will be notified of acceptance (editorial board) or need of revision. Page proofs will be sent to the author or the first-mentioned author in the case of multiple authorship for checking. Corrections of proofs must be restricted to printer's errors. Authors are particularly requested to return their corrected proofs as quickly as possible.

**Reprints.** Each author can get a **free e-reprint** (PDF) for personal use; for print of copies for own use or exchange with other researchers. They are expressly not allowed for deposition in a library/website/ftp-site for public access. Printed copies of each publication in the form of the regular reprint can also be produced by the Publisher for purchase by authors at cost to authors.
